Tsuneji Sano is a Professor of the Department of Applied Chemistry, Graduate Scholl of Engineering at Hiroshima University, where he has been since 2005. He received B.E. (1976) from Niigata University, and M.E. (1978) and Ph.D. (1981) from Tokyo Institute of Technology. He worked in National Institute of Materials and Chemical Research at AIST (1982-1993). Thereafter, he worked as an Associate Professor and a Professor at Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (1993-2005). His research fields are syntheses, characterization and applications of zeolites, including dealumination-realumination behavior and zeolite membranes. He received an Award from Catalysis Society of Japan in 2013.
