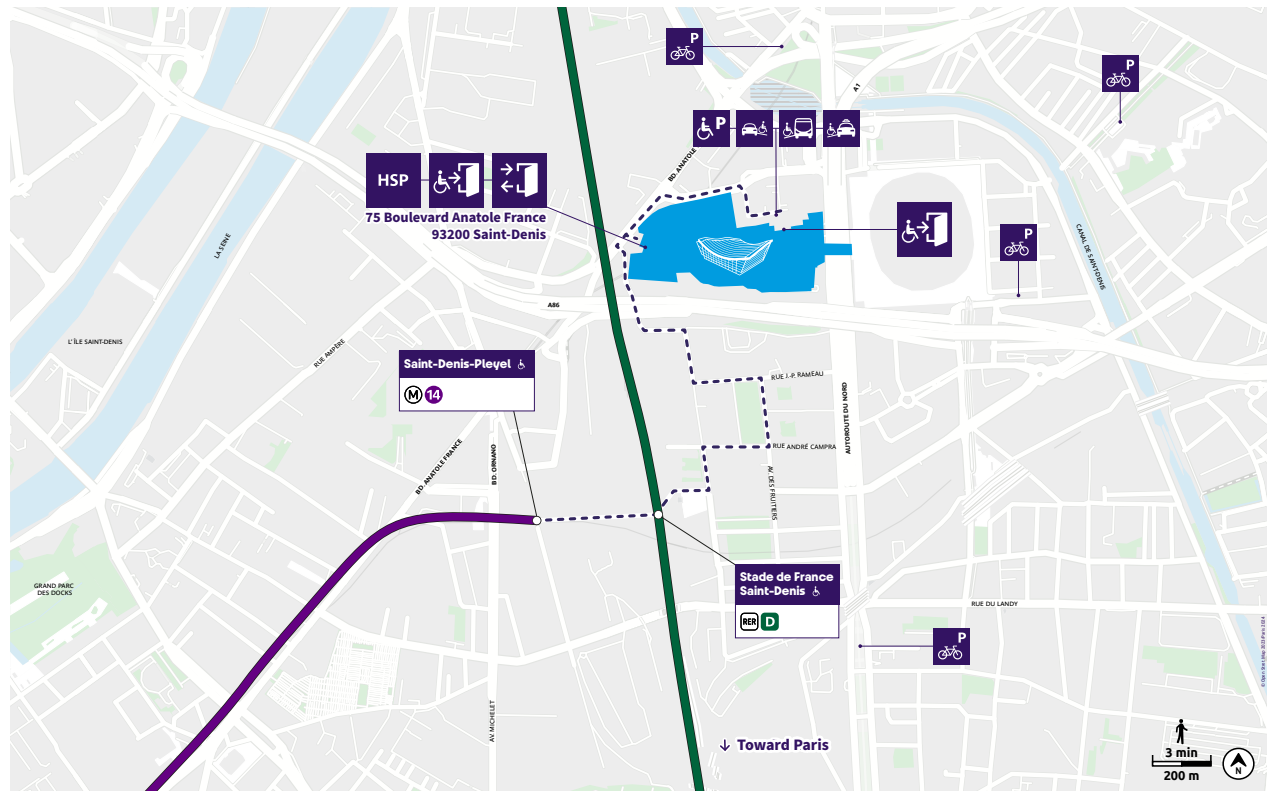

OUR ADVICE

Avoid taking metro line 13 and RER B which will already be in high demand for access to a number of venues (Stade de France, Olympic Village, North Paris Arena, Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport, etc).
