

Take the REP D or metro line (M) 4 to reach the competition venue. Given the simultaneous organisation of various competitions in the Île-de-France region, large numbers of passengers are expected on public transport services. If possible avoid taking metro line (M) 13 and the RED. It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at least 1 hour 30 before the start of the session. For some competitions, metro line 13 will not be accessible when leaving the venue.
