### OUR ADVICE

It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at least 1 hour 30 before the start of the session.

If you have a Paris 2024 general public ticket: alight at the station Iéna (M9) or Pont de l'Alma (RER C). Use entrances 10 or 11 to access the venue. If you have a guest ticket: alight at the station Trocadéro (M6 and M9). Use the guest entrances located on the Droits de l'Homme forecourt to access the venue.
