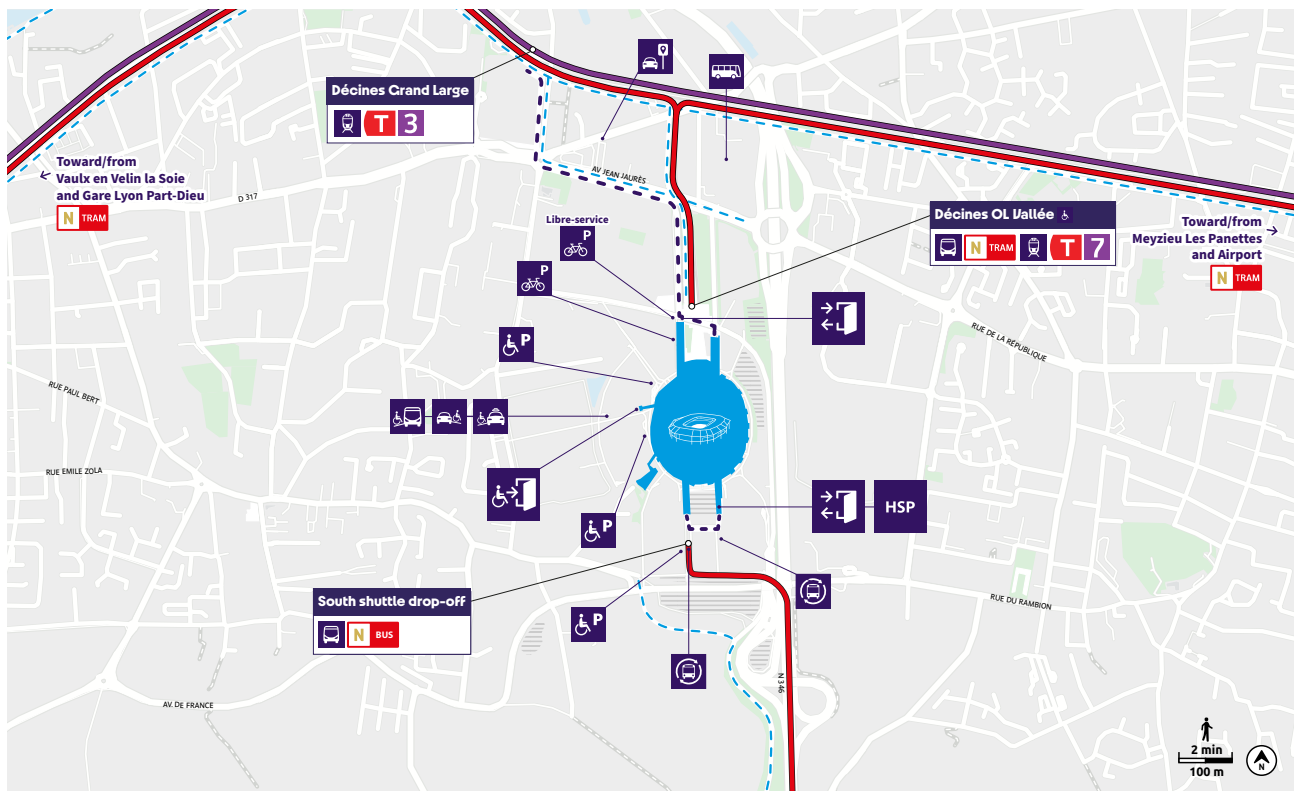

OUR ADVICE

It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at least 2h30 before the start of the session.
