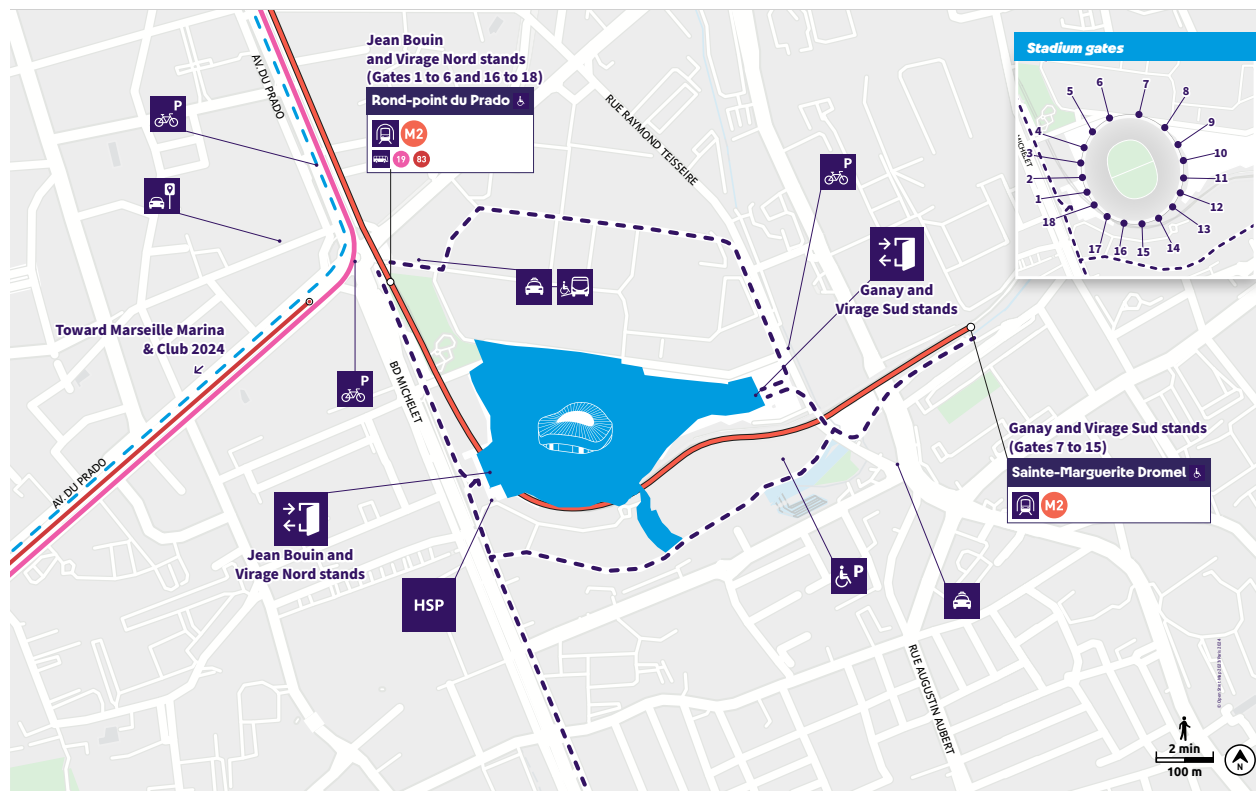

NOTRE CONSEIL

It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site 2h30 before the start of the session.

If your ticket indicates "Jean Bouin or Virage Nord stands", use the roundabout at Prado station and go to the Jean Bouin entrance via Boulevard Michelet. If your ticket indicates "Ganay or Virage Sud stands", use the Sainte-Marguerite Dromel station and go to the Ganay entrance via Rue Raymond Teisseire.
