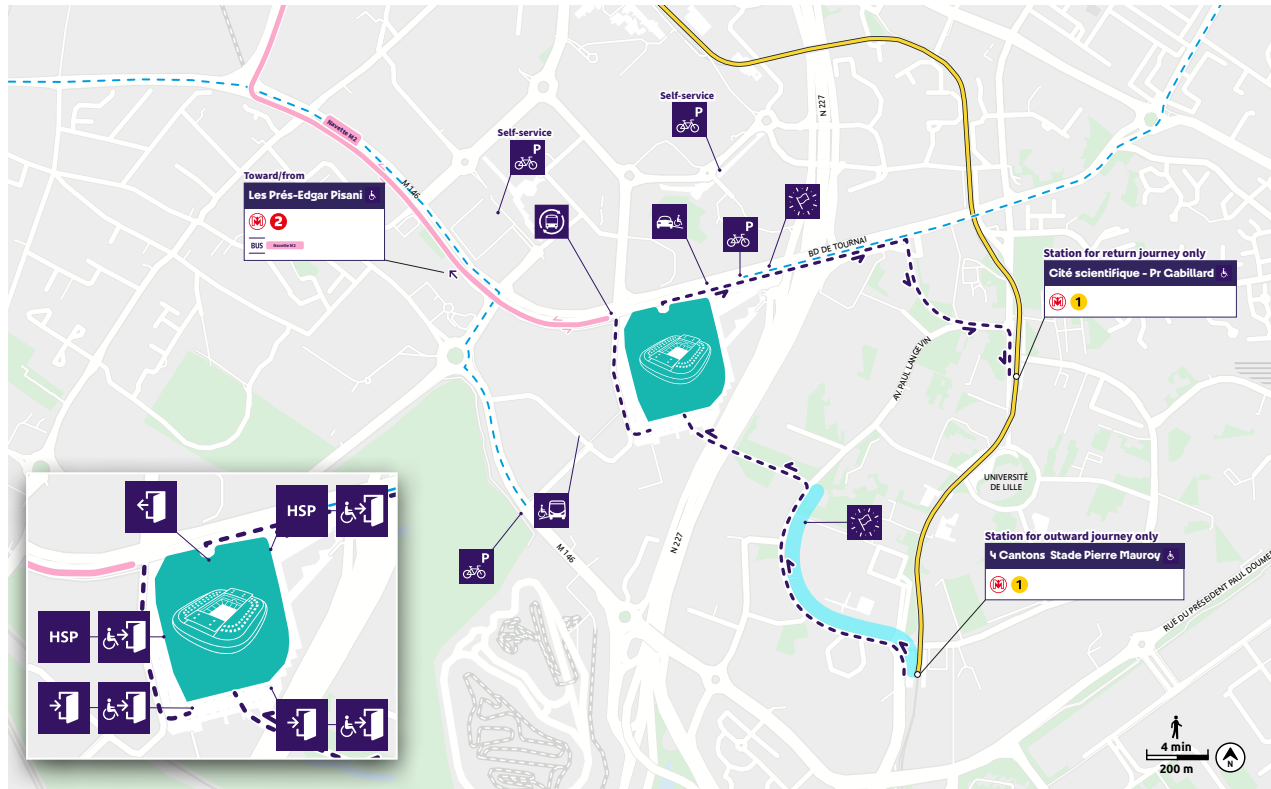

If you take the M1 metro, you have to get off at the "4 Cantons Stade Pierre Mauroy" station to reach the site entrance located in the south. However, as the stadium exit is at the north, the return journey on the M1 is from the "Cité scientifique - Pr Gabillard" station. It is strongly recommended to arrive on site at least 1h30 before the beginning of the session.

The last train from Lille to Paris leaves at 9:02pm every day. We invite spectators to take this information into account in order to organise their trip and accommodations. On the 6th and 07th August, the departure of the last train from Lille-Europe has been postponed to 21:50.
