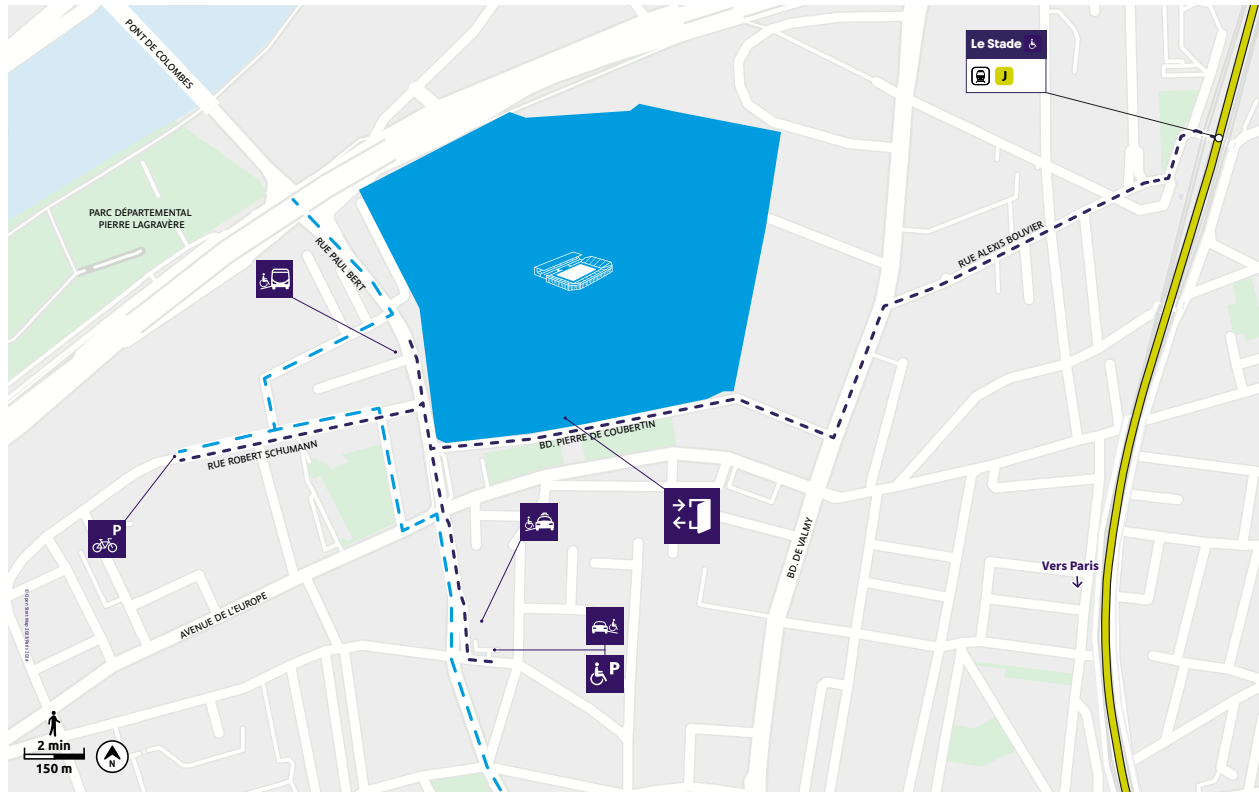

Given the simultaneous organisation of various competitions in the Île-de-France region, large numbers of passengers are expected on public transport services. **It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at least 1 hour 30 before the start of the session. To improve access, there is a special ticket inspection line at each entrance for spectators with tickets for several sessions on the same day.**

As the venue is outdoors with few shaded areas, we recommend bringing suitable clothing and accessories for the weather.
