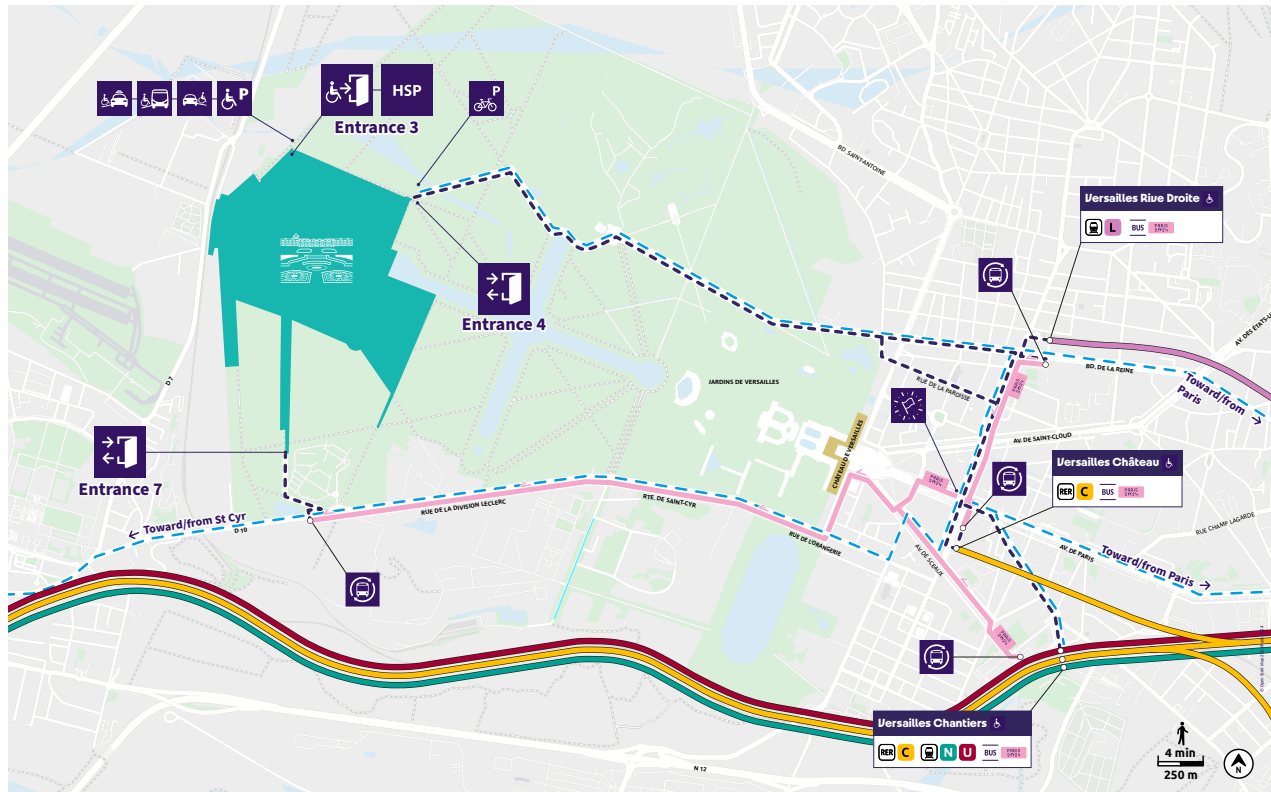

OUR ADVICE

We recommend arriving at the venue 1 hour 30 before the start of the session, and taking the free Paris 2024 buses reserved for spectators.

Please note that the distance on foot between the Paris 2024 bus drop-off and the stands is around 20 minutes. For more energetic visitors, the venue can also be accessed via the Entrance 4 (North-East), around an hour's walk from the stations indicated on the map above. As the venue is outdoors, we recommend dressing suitably for the weather.
