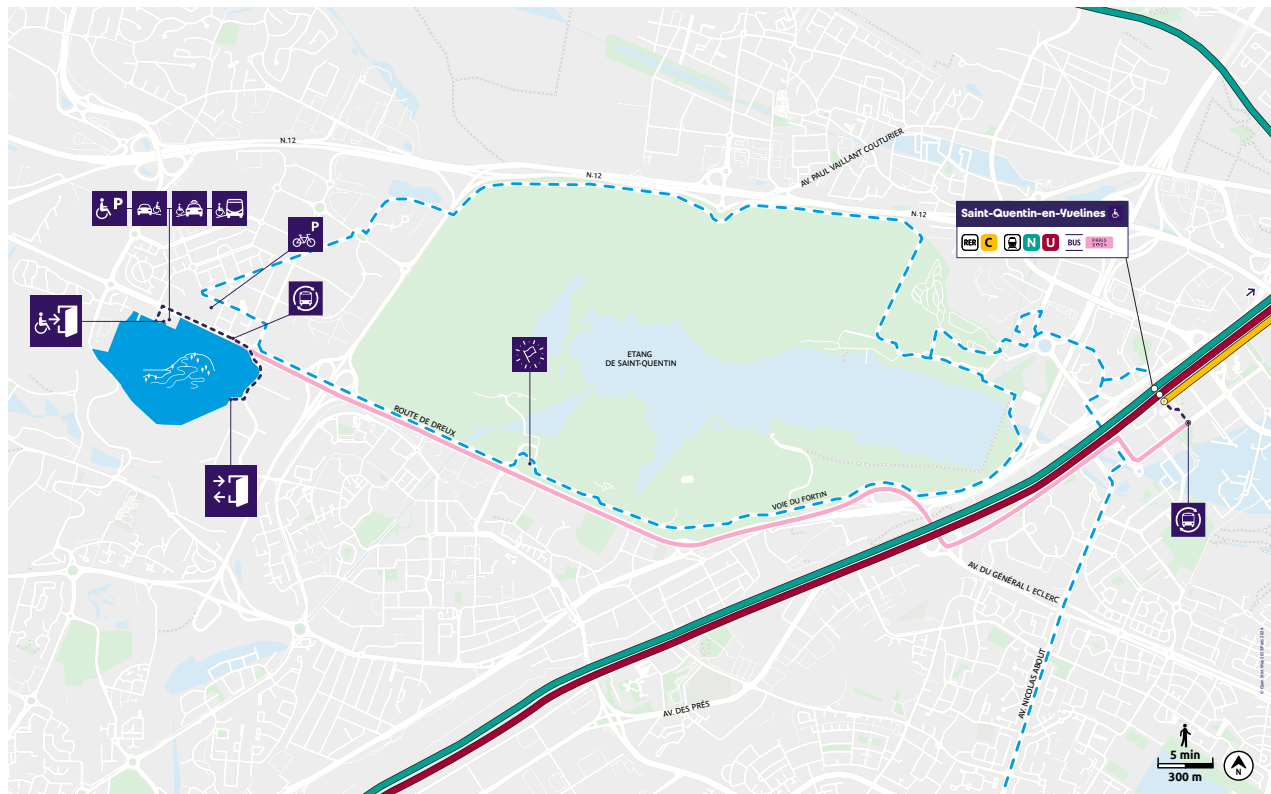

OUR ADVICE



It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at least 1 hour 30 before the start of the session.

As the venue is outdoors, we recommend bringing suitable clothing and accessories for the weather (wide rimmed hat, sunglasses, foldable small umbrella, water bottle, etc.). Given the steep nature of the venue, we recommend wearing closed footwear such as hiking shoes and bringing a walking stick for people who have difficulty walking.
