

OUR ADVICE

- 1 It is mandatory to use the spectator shuttles to reach and leave the venue. Please note that there are no footpaths leading to the site.
- \triangle These shuttles are free on presentation of a ticket for a session of the day.
- A first security check will be carried out when boarding the shuttles. It is advisable to arrive at the site at least 1H30 before the beginning of the session (2 hours before for the session on the 2nd of August).
- Please note that the RD 925 will be closed to traffic (excluding spectator shuttles) during the Games.
- Trom the 27th of July to the 5th of August, a train departing from Paris Austerlitz at 5:18am from Monday to Friday and 5:37am during weekends will take you to Châteauroux station, where you can arrive at the competition venue on time via the city centre shuttle bus.
