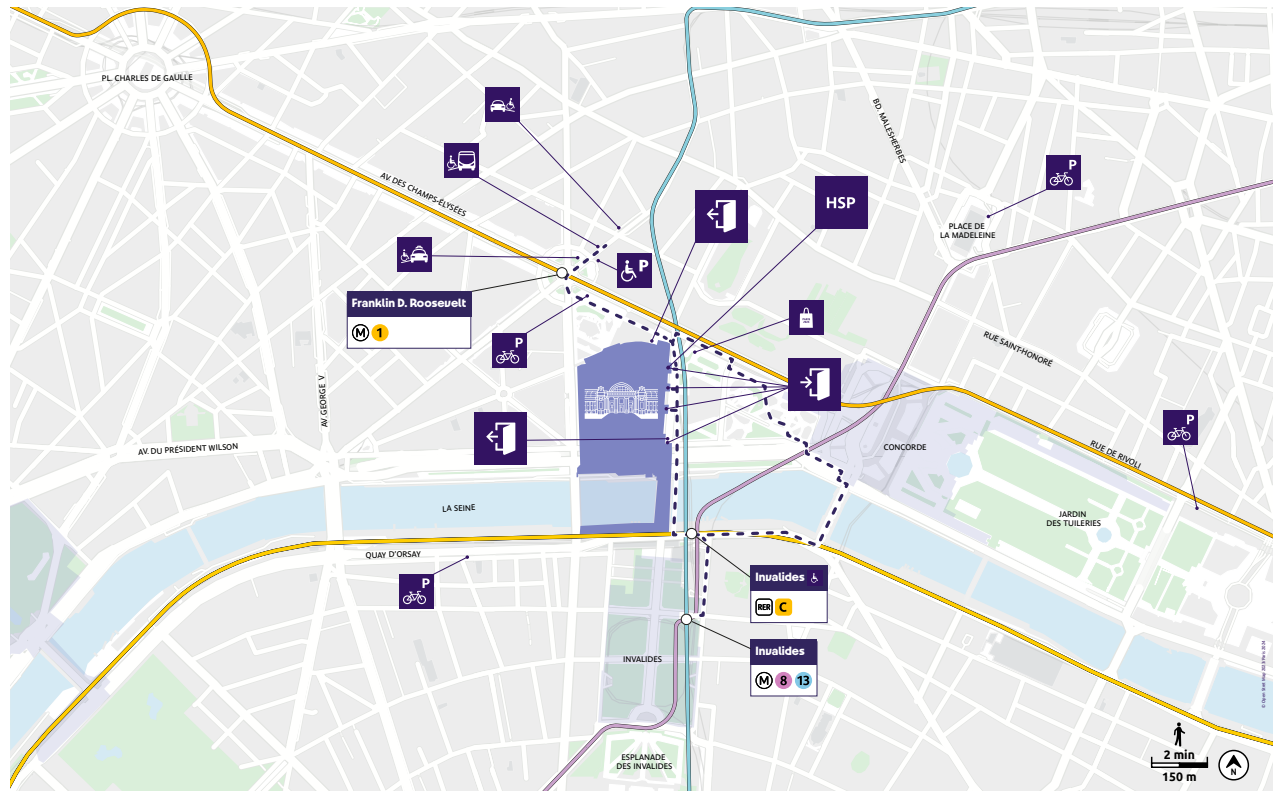

### OUR ADVICE

It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at least 1h30 before the start of the session

The Grand Palais can be accessed via Pont Alexandre III bridge except for competition days. There will be no access via Pont des Invalides either on competition days. Please use Pont de la Concorde to access the venue from the left bank, where the "Invalides" station is located.

Buy your transport ticket(s) in advance to avoid queuing at the station.
