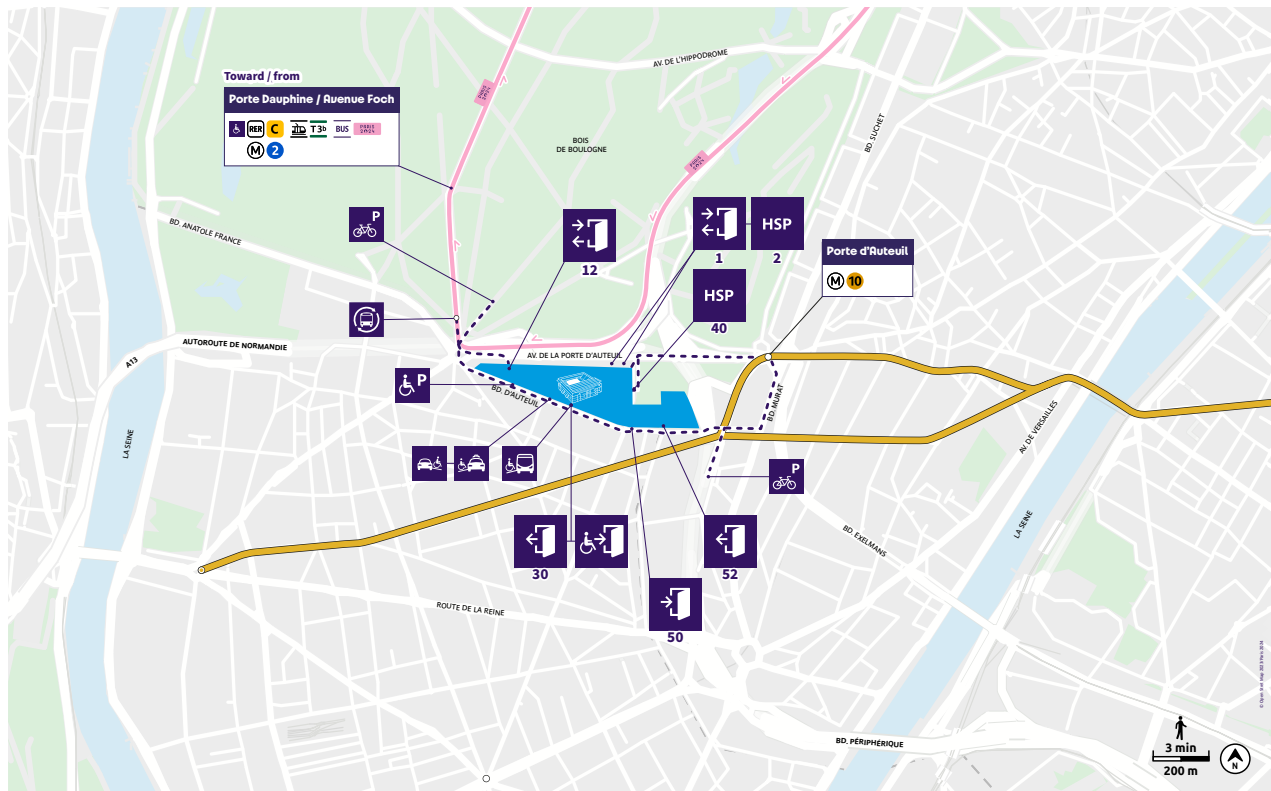

OUR ADVICE

Use the the free shuttle bus reserved for spectators from the "Avenue Foch / Porte Dauphine" stop to access the competition venue.

Given the simultaneous organisation of various competitions in the Île-de-France region, large numbers of passengers are expected on public transport services. **It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at least 1h30 before the start of the session.**
