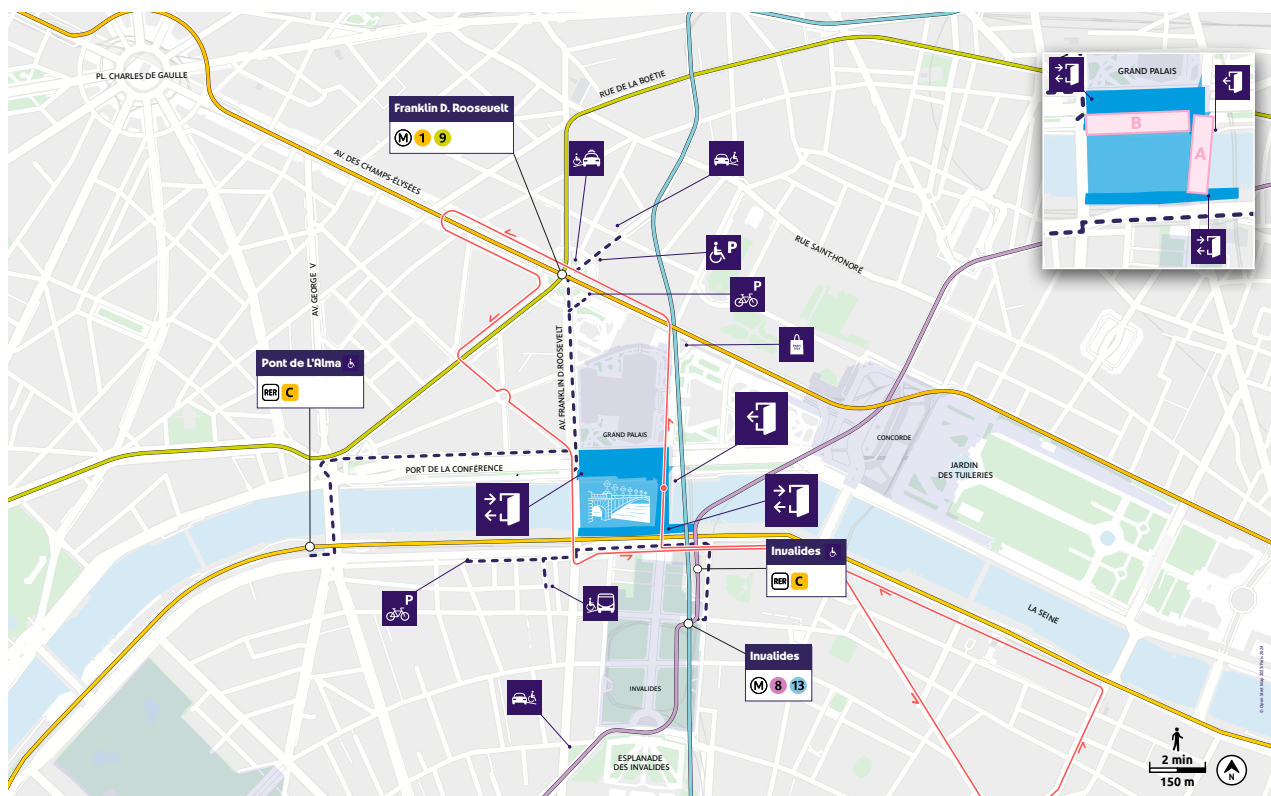

It is strongly recommended to plan sufficient time for
your journey on public transport and to arrive on site at
least 1h30 before the start of the session. If your ticket is
marked **Grandstand A**: alight at the “Invalides” stop.

If your ticket is marked **Grandstand B**: alight at the “Franklin D. Roosevelt” or “Pont de l'Alma” stop. Pont des Invalides and Pont Alexandre III will not be in use. A number of roads will be closed to pedestrians during the race, with designated crossing points along the route. Please follow the pedestrian paths indicated on the map.
